ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION TO 30MPH

Various roads around A164 - Beverley Road - Cottingham to Minster Way Beverley

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 30mph on the following roads for the duration of the Jocks Lodge Improvement Scheme Works:

A164 - Beverley Road, starting 100m South of Skidby Roundabout and ending at Victoria Road Roundabout
Beverley, incorporating Beverley Road Bentley, Beverley Road Woodmansey.
Skidby Roundabout, Skidby
Main Street, Skidby - 50m West of Skidby Roundabout to Skidby Roundabout
Harland Way, Cottingham - 100m East of Skidby Roundabout to Skidby Roundabout
Dunflat Road Bentley - extending 100 meters from the junction with the A164 Beverley Road.
Main Street Bentley extending 100 meters from the Manor Farm Cottages to the A164 Beverley Road.
Lincoln Way - Beverley between the junction with Victoria Roundabout and the junction with Regiment Roundabout
Regiment Roundabout, Beverley
Minster Way, Woodmansey extending 400 meters from Regiment Roundabout.

The speed restriction will come into force on 8th January 2024 and is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the restriction will be lifted by 8th July 2025.
